Colcord High School will be offering, to eligible students—**Driver Education Training** beginning on Wednesday, May 24<sup>th</sup>. (Classes Begin)

To be eligible, as student must be 15 years of age by June 1<sup>st</sup> of 2017. All students can apply—we will accept the first 60 applications.

**Cost for the class will be \$150.00 for each student, to be paid in full (cash or money orders only) by enrollment day (May 23<sup>rd</sup>).** You may pay at any time before that date as well.

Make payments to Phillis Smith in the high school office. No refunds will be available.

The class will consist of 30 hours (10 days/2 weeks) of classroom training and 12 hours of observational driving-6 hours of actual driving.
