



Your Partner in Keeping Children Healthy

- The Oklahoma Caring Van Program provides on-site immunization clinics at schools, child care facilities, and community locations.
- Vaccines are offered at no charge to children who are Medicaid-eligible, uninsured, or American Indian.
- All vaccines required for school and child care are available.
- A registered public health nurse administers all vaccines.
- An updated copy of each child's shot record is provided at the conclusion of each clinic.
- Parents may provide advanced consent if they are unable to attend the clinic and records are pre-screened.

- ◆ All Children between 2 and 18 years of age are eligible.
- ◆ Height and weight data are collected.
- ◆ Parents receive an individualized report and list of no-cost and low-cost resources in their community.
